**ANNUAL REGISTRATION FEE** \$50 for new students and \$20 for returning students with a maximum of 2 registration fees per family. Registration fee is non-refundable, non-transferable, and not eligible for credit on your account. Discounts do not apply to the registration fee.

**PRIVATE LESSON PAYMENT PLANS** Tuition can be paid in full, in two payments, or in monthly installment payments. A one-time \$30 finance fee is charged for two payments. A one-time \$50 finance fee is charged for monthly payments. Registration and Finance Fee paid at time of enrollment. Registration and Finance fees are non-refundable.

**INSTALLMENT PAYMENTS** Credit Card must be provided at time of enrollment and will be automatically billed on the first of the month. Any credit card payment that is declined will be subject to a \$40 late fee after the 7th day of the month.

**TRIAL LESSON FEE** Students may take 1 trial lesson at the standard tuition rate for private lessons. No trial lessons are available for group classes.

**PIANO ACCOMPANIMENT FEE** Students will pay fee directly to accompanist with cash or check. Check with your accompanist for current rate.

  your instructor and the school office. Make-up lessons must be arranged with your instructor and are
  based on their availability.
- There are no make-ups for missed group classes.
- When a private lesson is cancelled by the instructor, you will be notified and a make-up lesson will be arranged by your instructor. Make-up lessons can be done virtually if needed with the approval of your instructor.
- In a case of inclement weather or other circumstance beyond our control, lessons and group classes may be switched to virtual/online or rescheduled.
- Harmonia may cancel any group class with insufficient enrollment numbers. If that happens we will
  provide a full refund to your account.
- There are NO make-ups or refunds offered for Summer Lessons

**PRIVATE LESSON CANCELLATION** If you wish to drop your enrollment from private lessons your are required to submit a 1 month drop notice to the school office. Please send your official drop request to harmonia@harmoniaschool.org. Once your drop request is recieved we will notify your instructor and adjust your account billing to reflect your last lesson date. You are responsible for payment on any remaining lessons up to your last lesson date.

**STUDENT DROP OFF AND PICK-UP** For the safety of all students, parents are advised to escort their children to the classroom. Parents should pick up students in person immediately following their lesson or group class.

**OBSERVATION** It is recommended that parents with small children be present during private lessons. Some piano and other group classes may require parent participation as part of the curriculum. Please check with your instructor or the school office for requirements.

**INSTRUCTOR REPLACMENT** Harmonia reserves the right to replace instructor(s) without causing any discontinuity in student's study. If this happens a student has the right to switch to another studio without penalty as long as there is an opening. Once a switch has occurred a student must give a 1 month notice prior to switching again.

**SCHOOL CLOSINGS** Harmonia does not follow any county school closings. We are open on all Monday holidays except for Labor Day, Memorial Day, Spring Break, and Winter Break. ## THEATER CLASSES AT HARMONIA

**To all of our Theater parents and students.** We are so glad that you have found our programs. We want you to have a great first Theater Experience. Joining a theater program can be a large commitment and since there are no refunds given once a group class begins we highly recommend you take a moment to learn a bit more about our programs before you make a decision to complete your enrollment.

- Our Theater group classes are designed for beginning, intermediate, and advanced students. The typical progression will see students beginning with Summer Theater Camp, and moving on to Theater Kidz or Rising Stars, and finally, Main Stage.
- The work is meant to be joyful, creative, inclusive, fun, and full of possibilities.
- Our programs typically conclude with a showcase based on a popular fairytale or story and in the case of MainStage, a full production. As the skill level increases so does the student commitment, difficulty and show requirements.
- Summer Camps, Theater Kidz, and Rising Stars DO NOT focus heavily on casting. Although
  we do cast parts for suitability, the class is not set up around a casting audition or
  competition. It is meant to take a group of students and help them develop their skills as
  they create a showcase together. The last day showcase is a reward to show the progress
  and hard work of our students. If your expectation or satisfaction is based solely on being
  cast in a particular role then these programs are not for you.
- Our participants must be willing to accept roles that are given. It is common for roles to
  develop and scenes or lines to be expanded to challenge students as they work together
  to create interesting characters on stage. Every role in musical theater is important to the
  story.
- Parents should be supportive and encouraging to our young actors.
